Wattamolla Sunrise (let's try again)

Same details as before ...

Meeting either at St George Bank (Sutherland) at 4.10am to leave at 4.20am SHARP or at the Wattamolla Gate at 4.45am. If the gate is open just drive in and we will see you in the carpark, or at the headland. Sunrise is at 5.37am so we want to be in position well before that.

BLOG

Unfortunately (typically) I have too many ideas, and not enough time to implement them. Getting the Society BLOG underway is one of the things that has suffered, but will finally kick off in 'beta format' over the Christmas holiday period. It is apparent that the communication link with Society members has become more difficult recently, as numbers have grown. Communication using a BLOG seems the only way to go.

In early January, I will be sending out information to all the people that are, or have been members of the Society. It will layout, easy to follow (step by step) instructions on how to register for the Society BLOG. Once registered, you will then have access to the BLOG as well as receive posts whenever a new Society BLOG Post is created (Newsletters, Outing Updates, Articles etc).

This will streamline communications and instantly inform you of Society updates as they occur.

The BLOG will have links to the Society Flickr site; the Society Facebook site, as well as other Photography sites you might be interested in. Your access to the various Society Categories will be via the Title Bar (Photographic Society) at the top of the Home page.

Includes:

Newsletters – Current Newsletters as well as previous Newsletters (archived) Stop Press – A BLOG post informing you of Urgent last minute information including opportunities for Society members to post information like: they are going on a sunrise shoot the next day and want to let other Society Members know, that if they want to come, they are welcome ...

or someone finds out about photographic opportunities on that day and wants to inform others. Note: Unlike Facebook posts (that only get to subscribers of Facebook) these posts will get to ALL the Society people that are registered to receive the posts.

Outing Updates – A BLOG post where Outing Update will be posted showing status of Outing. This will end up taking the place of the current notification system where you need to log onto the Society site to see if a Photographic Outing notice has been updated and whether it is ON or CANCELLED.

What's On – A BLOG post that will be updated as new information is received, showing Exhibitions, Events and Competitions'. Compiled by John Cole.

Market Place – A BLOG post where any Society members can list photographic items they would like to sell or buy.

Title Bar also includes:

Calendar – A BLOG post showing Society activities coming up (month to month).

'A Photographers' Thoughts' - A BLOG post where I will be writing articles on shooting different subjects and locations. There will be an overview on the location, the weather conditions, the equipment used (and why), the pro's and con's of the shoot, then images (as shot) and finally the finished 'enhanced' images of the shoot. All Articles will be archived for reference. **Photography Classes** – Upcoming classes and courses including: Introductory and Extension Courses, Portrait Course (still being designed – using models) and information on Lightroom 3 & 4 private classes (2 people).

So, when you receive the instructions to Register for the Society BLOG, fill in the Member Registration to be part of this exciting update to Society communications.

Note: Once the BLOG is up and running, the current website and emailed Newsletters will be phased out, but initially they will run parallel for 3 months, to give people enough time to register.

Trips Away in 2013
