### **Lightroom 5 Beta**

You can download the beta and use it until the product expires on June 30, 2013. <a href="http://www.adobe.com/cfusion/entitlement/index.cfm?e=labs">http://www.adobe.com/cfusion/entitlement/index.cfm?e=labs</a> lightroom5

#### **Beta**

What this means is you can download a trial version of the new software to test it before its release of the full version. They do this to get feedback on a soon to be released version, so they can tweak it before its release. Basically 20,000 people can test it for them and for some it allows the public access without buying it – then after using it, they will probably buy it anyway - Win/win Adobe ...

You log-in with your Adobe ID or create a new account to download Lightroom 5 beta. Adobe membership is free and registration only takes a minute.

### Some of the changes to Lightroom 5

- Advanced Healing Brush Easily remove objects and fix defects—even those with irregular shapes such as threads or lint—with a single brush stroke. Take precise control over what's being removed as you make unwanted objects just disappear.
- **Upright** Straighten tilted images with a single click. Upright analyses images and detects skewed horizontal or vertical lines. You choose one of four correction methods, and Upright can even straighten images where the horizon is hidden.
- Radial Gradient Lead your viewer's eye through your images with more flexibility and control.
   The radial gradient tool lets you create off-centre vignette effects, or multiple vignette areas within a single image.
- Offline editing with Smart Previews Easily work with images without bringing your entire library with you. Just generate smaller stand-in files called Smart Previews. Make adjustments or metadata additions to Smart Previews and your changes will be automatically applied to the fullsize originals later.
- Video slideshow sharing Easily share your work in elegant video slideshows. Combine still
  images, video clips, and music in creative HD videos that can be viewed on almost any computer
  or device.
- Improved photo book creation Create beautiful photo books from your images. Lightroom includes a variety of easy-to-use book templates, and now you can edit them to create a customized look. Upload your book for printing with just a few clicks.

I am hopeful of creating student ID's for my Photography School that will enable any students to be able to buy Adobe Photoshop Lightroom 5 at a student discount.
