Hi Everybody,

Thanks to everybody who came to the Xmas meeting last Wednesday night - great turn up considering it was not our usual Thursday night. We had close to 100 attended, and it was great to socialise over supper at the end of the meeting.

I launched the African Appeal for the n'Kwazi village pre-school 'Mayana', Rundu, Namibia, Africa at the meeting, to try and raise enough funds for them to be able to connect the solar hot water panel that was donated 3 years ago, but has never been connected, due to a lack of funds.

When connected, this solar panel will allow the pre-school kids to have a shower when they get to school each day. This is more important than you know, considering that mostly the only water in the village is carried from the river each day. Running water from a tap ... your kidding ...

Well a **BIG CONGRATULATIONS** to everybody that donated

as the pre-school WILL now have hot water this coming winter, as we have already raised over \$1,000 (R10,000) which will pay for this project. I must thank Ross Kilpatrick, for a motivational push 3 weeks ago, to make me do want I had planned after coming back from Africa.

Just a note as to how important this will be ... In winter they cannot have a shower when they get to school as the water in the pipes is frozen ...

This is NOT the end...

We are really spoilt living in the LUCKY COUNTRY. As Xmas approaches, there I still time for you to donate to this worthwhile cause.

It's great to know where your dollars are going, and how it will be spent ...

Another project that they intended to do when funds are available was to improve the Water Weil and piping that takes water from the river to the vegetable gardens (they are establishing) and the village. Tools for the vegetable garden are also high on the priority list.

So the appeal is going till the 15th December, 2015, so let's give them some extra help, and an even bigger supprise, from their friends in Australia.

This is an appeal not only to those Society Members who travelled to Africa in 2015, but to members who would like to support the Society in a donation of funds to help this African village community in central Africa.

Improvements will be documented (photographed) and also distributed to contributors.

Note: ALL money collected will go directly to the community, and NO deductions will be made except for a small international transfer fee, which will be disclosed to ALL contributors.

Still with Movement (up to 10 images)

What! Images of a static subject, with movement blur of a foreground subject.

Just as an idea, set up your tripod, then set your camera to take an image with a slow shutter speed like 1/15th sec to blur the foreground moving subject. Frame up your composition on the static subject and prefocus before changing the focus to M (manual).


