NEXT OUTING - Sunday 20th March

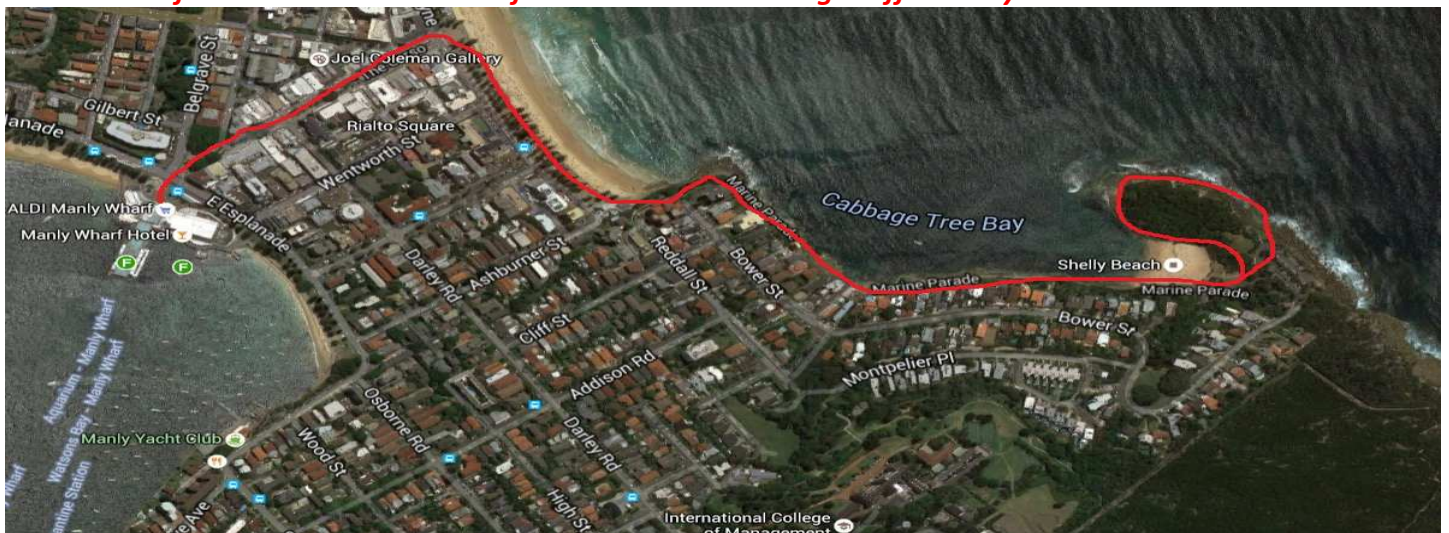
DATE: Sunday 20th March
