TASK for MARCH now APRIL's Task

Moonlit

This task is taking moonlit subjects with little or no ambient light other than the 'Light of the Moon' capturing long exposures, to make low light, bright light ...

(5 images)

This Task will now run over March & April due to the cloud from all the rain when the moon was full around 13th month.

April FULL moon is 11^{th} , so $9^{th} - 13^{th}$ will give you the best light for this Task

TO NEW Task for MARCH

TWIST

Taking slow shutter speed images while twisting the camera, to create a rotating image.

Firstly select a subject with plenty of light and colour variations. Next shut down the aperture to create a slow shutter speed – maybe also use ND or polariser to achieve that speed. Try to hold the centre of the subject, in the centre of the frame when twisting.
