PRESENTATION – 'Understanding Exposure'

Questions you might ask yourself ...

- Why do I get so much Noise, but only in SOME of my images?
- Why do some images lack the quality of others?
- What's these coloured bands I get sometimes?
- Do I 'Underexpose' or 'Overexpose' to preserve good tonal range?
- What does 'Clipping the Highlights' mean, and can I still recover them?
- Is RAW really all that much better than JPG?
- Does the histogram show my RAW image exposure correctly?
- Does Contrast really affect my exposure that much?
- Why not just let the camera work out the exposure itself?
- Is manually exposing really all that much better than using Auto, P, Av(A) or Tv(S)?
- So why don't we assume that if the exposure looks good on the camera screen, then it must be good!
