Some of the highlights include:

Victoria Falls - Chobe National Park (River Cruise and 4x4 Game Drive and park fees) - Okavango Delta Panhandle (Boat Cruise, Mokoro (dugout canoe) adventure), Nature Walks and Sunset Cruise – Etosha National Park (staying 3 days in the park (park fees included), walking distance to the animals at the waterholes) – Visiting the cultures of the Kavango & Himba people including village tour & school visit –

Twyfelfontein Rock Carvings – Petrified Forest – Thousands of Cape Fur Seals at the colony at Cape Cross – Guided Tour with Boesman (animal & plant survival in the desert) – Namib-Naukluft National Park and park - Desert (Sossusvlei, Dead Vlei, world’s highest sand dunes & park fees) - Kolmanskop ghost diamond mining town entry including tour – Fish River Canyon (world’s 2nd largest canyon) – Cape Town – Full Day Tour of Iconic Cape of Good Hope & Cape Peninsula & Penguin Colony, and animals, animals, animals, and beautiful Namibia Landscapes.

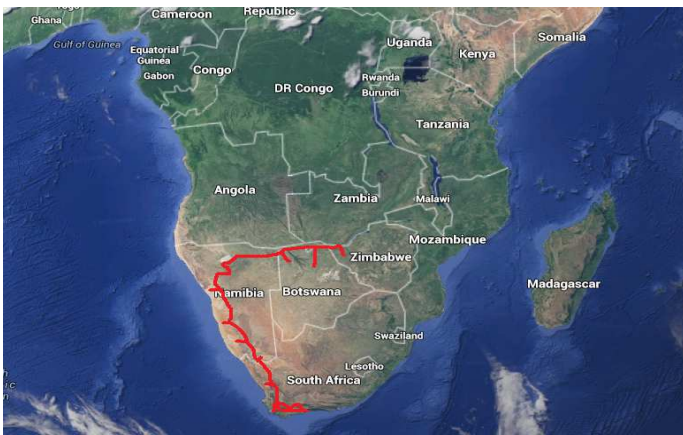
