The vastness of Namibia and embarking on a safari via road, entails driving distances that are at times long in between towns but the highlights of spectacular surroundings, a ghost town, stark desert colours, and surreal landscapes make this a remarkable and worthy trip.

'Climb Kilimanjaro 2020'


Kilimanjaro is known as "Everyman's Everest" because it is a challenge that is completely doable by laymen. If you asked around, you would probably find that you have a few friends, or friends of friends, who are not the most outdoorsy people yet have successfully stood on Uhuru Peak.

Mount Kilimanjaro does not require any technical skills. It is what is known as a "walk up" mountain because, well, you just walk up it. There is no need for mountaineering equipment like harnesses, ice axes or ropes because there is no danger of falling off a cliff or into a crevasse. Furthermore, there are no parts of the trail where one has to be particularly talented in rock climbing.


'Great Migration 2020'

The Great Migration winds through Kenya and Tanzania in a 1,000km long annular circular trek. With this Safari we will look for these animals in Tanzania, in the Northern Parts of the Serengeti. Witness a movement of over a million wildebeest, zebra and other antelope migrate across The Masai Mara and the Serengeti National Park in a clockwise movement, engaging in their courting, mating and birthing rituals. These surreal travels occur at different times of the year and absolutely worth a trip with the possibility of capturing even a snippet of this phenomenon.

'Zanzibar Spice Island 2020'


Zanzibar has a vibrant Islamic culture, beautiful white beaches and crystal clear blue water. A tour through Stone Town and the spice plantations is a must.

'Victoria Falls & Chobe National Park'


At Victoria Falls you can experience one of the seven natural wonders of the world. You need 2 full days to have enough time to view the falls from the Zimbabwe and Zambia side and do some of the many activities Victoria Falls town have to offer. Then transfer over to northern Botswana to visit Chobe National Park

Chobe National Park is known for its large herds of elephants and Cape buffalo, which converge along the Chobe Riverfront in the dry months. We do a spectacular sunset cruise on the Chobe River which is a photographer's paradise and an early morning sunrise game drive.
