The HELP Required

Marguerite Foxon is asking the following question for a friend on Apple & Lightroom:

Situation

I have an Apple iMac running Mac OS Mojave Version 10.14.6. I use Adobe Photoshop Lightroom 6.14, with a perpetual desktop licence, to manage my library of RAW images and to perform edits, which are generally limited to colour balancing, black and white conversion and cropping. I do not have a subscription to any of Adobe's Creative Cloud software. Apple have released, Catalina, the first 64 bit version of Mac OS.

Complication

My version of Lightroom will not run on Catalina.

Question

- 1. What are the favoured alternatives, to Lightroom, for library management and basic editing, that will run on Catalina and do not use a subscription licence model?
- 2. Can the software recognise and use the metadata stored in the XMP sidecar file for each photo?
