The Society Coffee chat groups (both ladies & men's) continue to be supported by the members, with the Ladies group meeting at the Gymea Bowling Club and the men at Tradies, on a Wednesday morning every 2nd week at 10am for a couple of hours. So many topics come up in discussion, and it is great to have an opportunity to share a cuppa with Society friends.

Our weekly Sunday afternoon Woronora walking Group enjoys a 4km social walk from 4pm, meeting at the old Woronora vehicle low level bridge, in the carpark next to the take-away.

We then walk at our own pace, around to the pedestrian bridge, then a loop up to where the fire trail from Engadine Heights joins the roads of Woronora, up past the RSL, and along the Sutherland side of the river, then over the road bridge. The group often splits, some walking at a more leisurely pace, but always with company ... For some, fish & chips seems to be a good way to finish the activity at the local café.

Friday night Photography Workshop Society Webinars start at 7.30pm and is generally broken up into 2 segments.

The first is an open discussion on a variety of images, talking about their appeal, composition, enhancement and crop options. Talking about how and why images appeal or don't, allows others' opinions to point out things that you might of not considered.

The second is concentrates on techniques of enhancement using Lightroom & Photoshop. With the advent of Ai, many elements of these programs have changed, or become superseded. Many of us realise that Ai is not going away, and if our interest in photography is to remain, then (in-part) we need to embrace it before we get left behind.

Upcoming TRIP AWAY – High Country Photography Staying at a lodge in Jindabyne (9th – 14th November)

We have been on three trips away to the high country before, and every time the area never disappoints for photograph opportunities. The landscape and the snow gum photography gives opportunities that only exist in this high-country environment.

There is the opportunity to stay in a lodge thanks to Jenelle in the Society, where they are offering very good rates. We are looking around \$40 p.p. per night with a mixture of room accommodation, twin and possibly private rooms, and shared facilities. A large lounge area and a commercial style kitchen, makes for all the facilities you may require.

You just bring towel, sheets, or sleeping bag, pillow and what you want to eat.

One (or two) night/s we will go out for dinner, and the rest you can eat-in if you wish.

We are planning to go on day outings into the high country to places like Guthega, Island Bend, Dead Horse Gap and Charlottes Pass.

We are also looking to go on a day outing south from Jindabyne along the Barry Way and The Snowy Way, to get access to the down-river Snowy area and fossicking along some of the higher country roads. There is a discussion about, on one day doing the Illawong Walk from Guthega, a 5km return walk, taking in a big variety of high country terrain and photography opportunities.

This trip has already had 14 people shown interested so have a quick think about it, and ring me to say yes please, or to ask any questions.

Accommodation dates: Sun night 9th November till Fri morning 14th November (5 nights) approx. \$200 p.p.













