NEWSLETTER No. 253 (05/06/2022)

Hi everybody,

It's great to see the member's interest in their photography being motivated again as we move on from the past couple of years of isolation & uncertainty.

Starting our monthly meetings at Tradies Gymea was a good move, although fragmented with COVID and wet weather interruptions. We are starting to build meeting numbers again with the last 3 meetings growing from 32 to 45 to 60 last week.

Must continue to thank those who have supported me with the Photographic Society interest, in Webinars on a Friday night's, outings, club meetings, weekly walks, and trips away. We are growing again, and look forward to your association, and friendships as we move to the future.

We have had a couple of trips away over the past 6 weeks that were supported by 33 members. The first was a high country road trip at the end of April into early May, through NSW & Victoria, exploring places like Jindabyne, Dead Horse Gap, Khancoban, Mt Beauty, Bogong, Falls Creek, Bright, Mt Hotham, Mt Buffalo, Mansfield, Mt Buller, Jamieson, Lake Eildon, and culminating with a camping over-night stay at Craig's Hut, high in the Victorian alps (the hut featured in the epic Australian film 'Man from Snowy River').

The second trip (only a week and a half later) was a trip to Kosciusko National Park High Plains area between Tumut & Adaminaby to try and fossick out the Brumbies that live in this vast area of the National Park.

We hired the whole of the east wing of the Yarrangobilly Caves House, which lies in the middle of the high plains, between Tumut & Adaminaby. What a great venue with heating, our own kitchen and lounge room. Not only did we visit the caves, but it was a central location to explore the plains.

Well Brumbies ...

We must of seen over 200 during the 4 day experience, yes some mobs were seen in different places, on different days, but all-in-all numbers far exceeded our expeditions.

Some of the things that stood out in our minds were how close we were able to get to them, the health of these brumbies, and their varied and beautiful colours, especially of their manes.

A satisfying insight from a National Parks employee, was the Brumbies in this area are not part of the necessary cull that is start in the near future. This certainly makes a difference to the way you view the images ...

Men's Coffee Chats (held fortnightly at Tradies – 10am) Next: Wed 15th June


